



PUBLIC NOTICE IS GIVEN

TO PERSONS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE WITH THE RIGHT TO BE REGISTERED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST OF THE ENTIRE MUNICIPALITY

1. During a council meeting held on October 13, 2020, Grenville-sur-la-Rouge municipal council adopted **By-law number RE-618-09-2020 decreeing the acquisition of two (2) new ten (10) wheels trucks with snow removal equipment and a loan of \$775,000.**
2. The qualified voters having the right to be registered on the referendum list of the Municipality may request that this by-law be the subject of a referendum vote. A request must be made in writing and contain the following information: the number or title of the by-law that is the subject of the request as well as the name, address and capacity of the person qualified to vote, supported by his signature.

This application must be accompanied by a copy of one of the following pieces of identification: health insurance card, driver's licence, passport, certificate of Indian status or Canadian Forces identity card.

In the event that the name of the person does not already appear on the list of qualified voters entitled to be entered on the municipality's referendum list, the request must also be accompanied by a document attesting to their right to be registered there.

3. Applications must be received by November 2, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. at the latest, at the municipal office located at 88 des Érables street or by email at: info@gslr.ca
4. The number of requests required for by-law number RE-618-09-2020 to be the subject of a referendum vote is 295. If this number is not reached, by-law number RE-618-09- 2020 will be deemed approved by those qualified to vote.
5. The result of the registration procedure will be published at 4:00 p.m. on November 2, 2020, at the municipal office located at 88 des Érables street and on the website: grenvillesurlarouge.ca.
6. The by-law can be consulted at the municipal office located at 88, rue des Érables and on the website: grenvillesurlarouge.ca.


Conditions for being a qualified person to vote with the right to be registered on the referendum list of the entire Municipality:

7. Anyone who, on October 13, 2020, is not incapacitated to vote as provided for in article 524 of the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities and meets the following conditions:
 - be a natural person domiciled in the municipality and have been domiciled for at least 6 months in Quebec, and,
 - be a major person and a Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship.
8. Any sole owner of a building or sole occupant of a business establishment who is not incapable of voting and meets the following conditions:

- be the owner of a building or sole occupant of a business establishment located in the Municipality for at least 12 months;
 - in the case of a natural person, be of legal age and a Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship.
9. Every undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-owner of a business establishment who is not unable to vote and fulfils the following conditions:
- be the undivided co-owner of a building or co-occupant of a business establishment located in the municipality, for at least 12 months;
 - be designated, by means of a power of attorney signed by the majority of people who have been co-owners or occupants for at least 12 months, as the one who has the right to sign the poll request on their behalf and to be entered on the list referendum, if applicable. This power of attorney must have been produced before or during the transmission of the request.
10. Legal person:
- have designated by resolution, from among its members, directors or employees, a person who, on October 13, 2020 and at the time of exercising this right, is a major person and of Canadian citizenship, who is not under curatorship and is not subject to no legal incapacity to vote.
